By taxing the necessities of life, Alabama taxes people deeper into poverty.

Everyone should shoulder a reasonable share of the costs for education, health care, public safety – the services that provide for the common good in Alabama. The heaviest load shouldn't fall on those least able to pay.

- **We're one of the two states that fully tax groceries.** Mississippi is the other.
- **Alabama has the highest income tax at the poverty line.** For a family of four making \$22,017, Alabama's income tax is \$483, the highest of any state.
- **High-income taxpayers don't pay their fair share.** The top 3% get more than half the benefit of a lopsided deduction, the state deduction for federal income tax paid. Everyone should pay a fair share.
